This is the 9th annual event, and again will be held at the Wellington and East Sawmill lots located on North Main Street and will feature 120 artists (same location as the Gathering at the Great Divide Art Festival Labor Day weekend.) This is one of the busiest weekends of the summer in Breckenridge, and this location is adjacent to the busiest section of the downtown business district, and the two largest parking lots of over 800 spaces. Close in town, easy loading and unloading, and local support all add up to the high quality show artists have grown to expect from *Mountain Art Festivals*, **Mark Beling, Director.**

Adding up all the facets of this show (great location, the busiest weekend of the summer, and large advertising budget), this show has proven to be a success.

### LOCATION

Breckenridge is located just 80 miles west of Denver via Interstate 70, then just 9 miles south on Highway 9. Once in our wonderful town, proceed on Main Street to the Show Site at the corner of North Main and Wellington Road.

### TIME

10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily. Artists must be set up until 6:00 p.m. all three days.

### CATEGORIES

Painting, Sculpture, Metal, Glass, Printmaking/ Drawing, Ceramics, Mixed Media. Jewelry, Wood, Fiber and Photography. All forms of original fine art and quality crafts. No factory-made items, machine molded items or imports. Artists must design, craft and represent your own work.

### SPACE SIZE

Approximately 10 x 10 feet. All spaces are on pavement outside. No inside or covered spaces are available. Space requests may not be guaranteed. **Please be prepared for all types of weather.**

### ARTIST RULES

Artists themselves must be present to exhibit and exhibit only their own original work - **No Exceptions.** A Picture ID may be required at check-in. Artists who don't comply with these rules may be asked to leave with forfeiture of fees.

### FEES

- A) The Application Fee is \$25. This check will be deposited upon receipt and is non-refundable. You must send \$25 for each category entered in a show. Example: If a person wants to apply in both Painting and Jewelry, send a \$50 check for the application fee. Only the categories accepted by the Jury may be displayed.
- B) The Space Fee for this year's show is \$450. Please include a **separate** check for each space request. **No Commission.** This check will be deposited only if you are accepted. Final decisions and deposit will be after the deadline dates. \$25 fee for returned checks.
- C) Corner spaces may be requested, if available, for \$100. Please include a **separate** check for this fee with the application. The corners will be awarded by the date application is received, and at the discretion of the show coordinators.
- D) No refunds after cancellation deadline date (see below), if accepted. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- E) Make all checks payable to:  
*Mountain Art Festivals*
- F) **NO Electricity** is available - SORRY!

### SLIDES and ACCEPTANCE REQUIREMENTS

Send 4 slides of your work and 1 slide of your display. The 5th slide must be a visible slide of your display that would ideally include the same kind of work shown in the other four slides. Slides must be only of the work and category to be displayed (if you wish to display more than one category, you must jury 4 slides of each category and be accepted in each category you apply for). **Five digital images on a CD are also acceptable (no e-mail files).** Format should be jpeg, no larger than 2.0 MB, 1920x1920 pixels, 300 dpi. Please include a **self-addressed stamped envelope** for either acceptance information or the return of images, if not accepted. If accepted, your slides will be returned at the show. All applications incorrectly filled out will be returned!
